Meals

Our camp chefs (Cameron and Becca) are experienced in creating meals that are safe, nutritious, and satisfying for all campers, so you can rest assured that your child will be well-fed and energized for all of the exciting activities and adventures that await them.

Equipment Provided

The field equipment below will be provided by My Nature Lab for all campers. Lights, hooks, and nets will be assigned to each camper in the morning and checked back in for charging, etc. each evening. Lost or damaged equipment will be charged the cost of replacement at the end of the program.

What to Bring

- Sturdy Footwear
- Water Shoes we recommend old tennis shoes
- Flip Flops/sandals for pool
- Insect Repellent
- Sunscreen
- Day pack about 20 liters big enough to carry a water bottle, rain jacket, and change of clothes
- Water Bottle At least 24 ounces staying hydrated is crucial, even at night
- Layers of Clothing: Prepare for temperature changes, bright sun, tall grass, creek wading and pack changes of clothes
- Rain jacket
- Sleeping Bag: Provides warmth and comfort during the night
- Sleeping Pad or Twin Air Mattress
- Pillow
- Swimsuit
- Toiletries: Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, medications, etc.
- Towel: For drying off after swimming or showering

Cost and Application Process

The all-inclusive cost of \$1,600/participant for the Critter Camp Overnight Adventure at My Nature Lab covers all aspects of your child's unforgettable experience. This fee includes nutritious meals and snacks throughout the camp, lodging at My Nature Lab, transportation to and from exciting field trips and excursions, and a refreshing visit to a local pool to beat the summer heat. With everything taken care of, your child can focus on learning, exploring, and creating lasting memories.

The priority application deadline is April 1, 2025. All applications received by this date will be reviewed promptly and decisions will be sent by April 15, 2025. If spots remain, applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis until May 15th when applications will close. The Overnight Adventure Critter Camp application has two parts; part one must be completed by the prospective student participant, and part two must be completed by parents. Parents may not complete part one of the application for their children. If we suspect that parents applied for their children or if an application was written using Al, we may require a follow-up interview or ask you to resubmit your application.

If your child's application is accepted, an \$800 non-refundable deposit due within two weeks of acceptance notice is required to secure your child's spot. The remaining balance is due two weeks prior to the start of your child's camp.

Participant Requirements

All participants must: meet the age requirements, be willing and able to walk up to two miles, be willing and able to get up early and stay up late, be comfortable walking through tall grass and wading across shallow creeks, follow directions, and stay with the group at all times. If your child does not meet all of these requirements, My Nature Lab reserves the right to withdraw your child from the program without a refund.

Age Policy

Age eligibility for programs is evaluated based on a child's age as of October 1, 2025. If you register your child for a camp and they are not of the appropriate age, your registration will be refunded minus a \$25 administrative fee.

Cancellation and Transfer Policy

No refunds will be given for cancellations. If your child is unable to attend a camp session for which they are registered, you will be charged the full amount and it will be considered a donation to the Center for Snake Conservation - My Nature Lab. If your child cannot attend, you can:

- (1) Transfer your child to another session. Transfer requests must be submitted to info@mynaturelab.org at least 30 days prior to the start of the camp for which they are registered.
- (2) Transfer your registration to a family member or friend of the appropriate age. Transfer requests must be submitted to info@mynaturelab.org and must be approved before a transfer is accepted. Restrictions may apply.
- (3) Request a donation receipt for the full amount of a canceled camp registration.

In the event that a program is canceled by My Nature Lab, registrants will receive a full refund. Transfer requests will incur a \$25 administrative fee.
