Payment, Cancellation, & Transfer Policy, Age Policy, and Participant Requirements

Payment, Cancellation, and Transfer Policy

Registration is available for the full year only.

A non-refundable deposit is due at registration: \$300 for 5 hour programs, \$180 deposit for 3 hour programs

Payment Schedule: At registration, select either payment in full or payment by session. If you select payment in full at registration, you will receive a 15% discount on program fees. Invoices for payment in full will be sent on June 1st (due June 15th). Invoices for payment by semester will be sent on June 1st (due June 15th) and November 1st (due November 15th).

- 5 Hour Budding Biologists, Life Scientists, Junior Biologists, Senior Biologists, Ecologists
 - In full (includes 15% discount): \$1908 due June 15 (\$2208 total)
 - By session: \$1299 due June 15 and \$999 due November 15 (\$2598 total)
- 3 Hour Budding Biologists, Life Scientists, Junior Biologists
 - In full (includes 15% discount): \$1146 due June 15 (\$1326 total)
 - By session: \$780 due June 15 and \$600 due November 15 (\$1560 total)
- 3 Hour Hatchlings
 - In full (includes 15% discount): \$1248 due June 15 (\$1428 total)
 - By session: \$840 due June 15 and \$660 due November 15 (\$1680 total)

For late registration after the initial billing period, bills will be issued within three days of registration and will be due in two weeks or before the next session of the course, whichever comes first. Bills will be prorated to reflect the number of sessions remaining in a program. Email info@mynaturelab.org to request information about setting up a payment plan if you require financial assistance.

Late payments will incur a \$50 fee. Students with unpaid balances at the start of their program will not be allowed to attend their program until all outstanding balances are paid. Students with unpaid balances may lose their spot in the program for which they are registered.

No refunds will be given for cancellations. If your child is unable to attend the program for which they are registered, you will be charged the full amount and you can either:

- (1) Transfer your registration to a family member or friend of the appropriate age. Transfer requests must be submitted to info@mynaturelab.org and must be approved before a transfer is accepted. Restrictions may apply.
- (2) Request a donation receipt to the Center for Snake Conservation - My Nature Lab for the full amount of a canceled registration.

Age Policy

All students must meet the age requirements below (as of October 1, 2025). If students do not fall into these age categories and have not received written approval to register, their registration will be canceled minus a \$25 administrative fee.

Hatchlings: Ages 4-5 (rising Pre-K and Kindergarten; age as of October 1, 2025)

Budding Biologists: Ages 6-7 (1st and 2nd grade, age as of October 1, 2025)

Life Scientists: Ages 8-9 (3rd and 4th grade, age as of October 1, 2025)

Junior Biologists: Ages 10-11 (5th and 6th grade, age as of October 1, 2025)

Senior Biologists: Ages 12-13 (7th and 8th grade, age as of October 1, 2025)

Ecologists: Ages 14+ (High School, age as of October 1, 2025)

Participant Requirements

All participants must be fully potty trained, follow directions, and stay with the group at all times in the Lab and in the Field. Conditions in the field may be uncomfortable (tall grass, heat, cold, water, long walks, etc.) and students must be prepared for these conditions and be able to stay with the group. Students must demonstrate respectful behavior towards other students, educators, property, Lab/wild animals, etc. at all times. Bullying and inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated. If your child does not meet all of these requirements, My Nature Lab reserves the right to withdraw your child from an individual lesson or the program without a refund.
